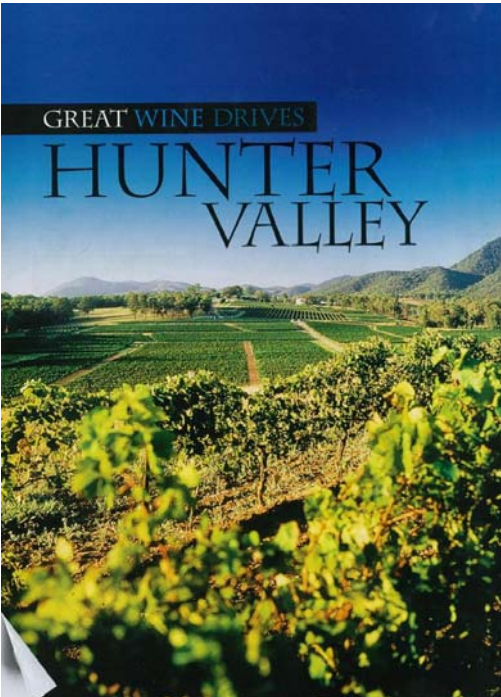

“On the home stretch now and heading towards a modern legend, **BROKENWOOD**. Although it brings in fruit from many regions around the country, its home is still in the Hunter Valley, which is the source for two of its finest wines. Semillon, unsurprisingly, has always been a stalwart, with the vintage releases well worth a look. While the 2004 Brokenwood Oakey Creek Vineyard Semillon pips it with some lovely fresh acid lines and a touch of lanolin complexity. Then there is the 2007 Brokenwood Graveyard Shiraz, which has already gained legendry status. A hunter classic in the making with the unique local fingerprint of power combined with a seductive texture and silky tannins that will see it drink beautifully for at least a decade if not two. Its definitely one for the cellar.”
